



Volunteer Positions

Access Control

This team of volunteers will ensure restricted areas are monitored and secure as well as maintain back of house areas. Also on this team will be “floaters” who could be called on in any position at any time. Knowledge of the venue and the accreditation system will be required. Key assets for this role would be those who enjoy talking to people, willingness to assist wherever necessary and good problem solving skills. Shifts in this department would typically be before, during and after games. Shifts in this department may cross over into Team Services as well.

Team Services

During all the games this busy team will be involved in maintaining the dressing rooms and bench area for all teams. Facilitating snacks, towels and laundry between all areas in the underbelly of the arena will keep this crew busy before, during and after all games and practice times. Knowledge of the game, equipment handling and willingness to take direction are key attributes of a volunteer in this department.

Game Day Experience

The delivery of a fun, action packed experience during game time will be the job of volunteers in this department. These people will assist with both the technical and entertainment fulfillment action behind the scenes. Volunteers in this team will be friendly and adaptable and willing to take direction in this fast paced department.

Team Hosts

Manage all aspects of the team's stay in Canada. Including but not limited to adhering to the schedule set out for the various areas: team game and practice schedules, food and beverage, transportation, communications, etc. The volunteer will be required to travel to various locations with the team throughout the duration of the team's stay. Each team will receive one team host for their duration of their time in Canada. It would be an asset for volunteers in this department to have a good understanding of Spanish.

Transportation

This group of volunteers will be required to transport the teams from various locations throughout the tournament. Including but not limited to transportation from the airport to their accommodations and the event venue. Drivers must be able to provide clean Driver's Abstract and possess a valid driver's license. Class 4 License is an asset.



Volunteer Services

The volunteers assigned to this task will be the volunteers' volunteers. They will be responsible for the volunteers' room (including but not limited to its upkeep, radio control etc.), as well as uniform distribution and check in and check out.

Floor Sweepers / Quick Wipers

This group of volunteers will be required to clean the floor during stoppages in play, timeouts, and in between sets with brooms (floor sweepers) and clothes (quick wipers for during play stoppages). High school and older elementary school students are ideal volunteers for this position.

3-Ball System

The 3-ball system has five volunteers positioned around the entire court to organize, control and keep the three game balls clean and available to both sides of the court. High school and older elementary school students are ideal volunteers for this position.

Volleyball Information System (VIS)

The VIS is used for the result management during FIVB World Competitions. The main purpose of VIS is to inform the national and international media on match results and on team and individual player statistics. Volunteers will be required to be proficient in utilizing the VIS and have completed proper training.
